

Notice of Public Hearing

Macon-Bibb County Transit Authority

Due to budget cuts from the Macon-Bibb County Board of Commissioners for the past two years, the Macon-Bibb County Transit Authority (MTA) will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, December 13, 2018** to receive community input on proposed changes to MTA's bus service. The approved changes by the MTA Board of Directors will become effective at least 30 days after approval.

The upcoming public hearing will be held in the Macon-Bibb County Planning and Zoning Conference Room located on the third floor of the Macon Terminal Station at 200 Cherry Street beginning at 5:30 p.m. on the day and time mentioned above. This hearing is being held in conformance with federal public hearing requirements outlined in Section 5307 (d) 1 of Title 49 U.S.C. and public hearing guidelines adopted by MTA's Board of Directors in 2018, as amended. We welcome passengers, employers, community-based organizations, and other affected stakeholders to participate in this public hearing.

Listed are the route adjustments under consideration. The proposed changes are expected to improve the efficiency of the public transportation system through a better use of limited resources. Please note that Paratransit customers residing in the jurisdictional boundaries of Macon-Bibb County will not be affected.

These proposed changes may be approved in whole, or in part following the public hearing and may include other alternatives derived from public comments. Interested members of the public are encouraged to attend the upcoming hearing and provide comments on service change proposals. Public comments will not be restricted to just the bus routes operating in one geographical area. All public comments received will be forwarded to the Macon-Bibb County Transit Authority Board of Directors to be considered prior to final action being taken on these proposals. Persons unable to attend the hearing may submit written comments postmarked through 12 /13 /18, to be included in the public record.
